PATROL OPERATION INFORMATION

Before Patrols- It is important that patrollers and the beach are set up and ready for a full day of fun. To ensure this, it is important that patrol members arrive 15mins before the patrol starts. This gives the patrol time to meet, prepare the beach and hold a team brief. The highest priority in opening the beach is making sure the flags are set, and the patrol signs on with Surfcom before 9:10am each morning. This ensures efficiency and that we comply with Branch and Council Agreements. If there is no lifeguard by 9:05am contact Surfcom via the radio and notify them the patrol is ready and waiting.

Patrol Uniform- Each patroller is supplied with a DHL patrol shirt and shorts. Each patroller should have their own red & yellow skull cap (spares may be supplied by the Patrol Captain). The Patrol uniform is a unique part to our organisation and is important making patrollers visible to the pub eye. The uniform also promotes our key partners and sponsors and it is important that we support them by wearing the correct uniform at all times.

General Operations- When arriving to the club the club house needs to be opened and the Australian and clubs flags need to be raised each day- this demonstrates our proud of our club and we are open for operation. All equipment needs to be checked at the start of each patrol to make sure everything is ready to use. Some little things to look out for include making sure there is ice in the freezer, enough water on patrol, sun cream is available and all patrollers are in the correct uniform.

Required Equipment- 2x patrol flags, 2x blue craft prohibited, 2x IRB training signs, 1x pair signal flags, 1x emergency evacuation flag, 1x loud hailer, 3x whistles, 3x handheld radios (in cases), 1x functional IRB, 2x rescue boards (and stands), 2x rescue tubes, 2x swim fins, 1x first aid kit, 1x oxy viva kit (ARC), 1x Streets patrol tent, chairs, 1x container of cold water & ice, sponsorship signs, patroller in DHL patrol uniforms, patrol log, hats & sunscreen.

Patroller Requirements- Each patrol must have an HBI, BBM holder (Patrol Captain), IRB Driver and Crew, ARC holder and there needs to be a minimum of 4x BM holders to open the beach.

Patrol Log Book- It is important that each patroller signs on and off the patrol book. The book is overseen by the Patrol Captain at the end of each patrol and will confirm your details. The club will not tolerate any false information in the log and those found guilty will be put forward to the Board of Management to discuss the appropriate action. To be eligible to sign on you must be in full DHL patrol uniform and on the beach- the Patrol Captain must confirm your attendance at the beach (time spent off the beach doing other duties other than patrolling will not be counted and crossed out). The patrol log is an accountable legal document and should be written in neatly and no offensive or inappropriate comments should not be written. If the person's name cannot be read they won't be recorded as having been on patrol.

After Patrol- At the conclusion of patrol, patrollers need to ensure equipment is put back in its appropriate position and gear is washed down. It is ok to begin packing up 15mins before patrol finishes to begin getting everything away unless it is a busy day- talk with the lifeguard to see what you may be able to arrange. You can start putting away the non-essential rescue equipment like the patrol tent, chairs etc. When loading the gear trailer make sure it is evenly loaded- you may need to do 2 trips over the hill to get everything over. The HBI will need to sign off with Surfcom over the radio in conjunction with the lifeguard. Once this has been done the beach is officially closed for the day and the Patrol Captain needs to sign off on the patrol log ensuring all stats and hours are entered correctly.

Faulty or damaged equipment- If you identify any faulty or damaged equipment please write it down in the patrol log so it can then be repaired. If things aren't reported you may be putting other club members in danger by continuing to use the equipment or endanger members of the public. Make sure the Patrol Captain is aware and write it in the book so the BMT can fix the equipment straight away.
